**1. Question:** In one section the requirement is for an Environmental Engineer to manage the project in another section it requires a Project Manager with specifying the professional degree. Our preference is to have a person with 20 years experience in Water issues to include environmental, etc as the team leader and hire engineers to support as their profession requires. Must the manager be an environmental engineer.

**1. Answer:** Need professional license environmental engineers to assess water sources, quality, and design water systems.

**2. Question:** In one section of the RFP it requires continuous on-going monitoring of water quality issues which seems to be for permanent operations or equipment installed during construction. By contract in other sections of the RFP it seems to limit this work to data collection, assessment and consulting. Are we required to install and monitor permanent water quality equipment?

**2. Answer:** Not water quality equipment is required. RFP requests data collection to assess water quality and provide potable water system designs.
