

# Argentina Airport Entry Fee

Airport Entry Fee

This warden message is being issued to alert U.S. citizens that on December 20, 2009, the Government of Argentina will begin charging American citizens visiting Argentina for business or tourism an entry fee of \$131 U.S. dollars. The fee will be collected only at Buenos Aires Ezeiza International Airport. Once paid, the fee permits multiple entries into Argentina for ten years in accordance with United States visa reciprocity. Americans may pay in dollars, by credit card, or with traveler's checks.

U.S. citizens may also call the Office of Overseas Citizens Services in the U.S. for the latest travel information.
