PLACE OF PERFORMANCE:

The Contractor shall carry out trash collection and recycling services for the United States Embassy Freetown and its residences.

DESCRIPTION:

The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular 2005-85.

The purpose of this firm fixed price contract is to obtain trash collection, re-use, re-purposing, disposal and recycling services for real property occupied by the U.S. Government in Post Freetown. The Contractor shall perform trash disposal and recycling services in all designated United States Government residences and the Chancery. The contract will be a one year (12 months) with one-four year options.

The contractor shall furnish all managerial, administrative, and direct labor personnel that are necessary to accomplish the work in this contract. A site visit will be held on June 16 & 21, 2016 at 10:00 am (local time) at the U.S. Embassy Freetown, Southridge, Hill Station, Sierra Leone.

Responsible Offerors must be registered in SAM (<http://www.sams.gov>). SAM registration must be completed to receive a contract award.

Offerors must respond to all criteria requested.
