Your quotation must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "**Quotation Enclosed (Strengthening of Perimeter Wall at GSO Warehouse)**" to, **GSO Warehouse at Plot 63/67 Spring Road, Bugolobi, Kampala, on or before 10:00hrs on January 23, 2013.**

No quotation will be accepted after this time.

Complete the offer portion of the Standard Form 1442, including all blank spaces, and have the form signed by an authorized representative of your company, or the proposal may be considered unacceptable and may be rejected.

The contract will be a firm fixed price contract with no adjustment for any escalation in costs or prices of labour or materials. Each offeror will be responsible for determining the amount of labour and material that will be required to complete the project and for pricing its quotation accordingly.

The Contracting Officer reserves the right to reject any and all quotations and waive any informality in quotation received. In addition, the Embassy reserves the right to establish a competitive range of one or more quoter and to conduct further negotiation concerning price and other terms before awarding the contract, or to award without discussions.
