Please submit two separate proposals (Technical and Price Proposal) in soft copy format to the above given email addresses on or before the deadline of 1200pm local time, Tuesday, July 26, 2011. No proposals will be accepted after the deadline.

The U.S Government intends to award a contract to the responsible company submitting an acceptable proposal at the lowest priced-technically acceptable offer. We intend to award a contract based on initial proposals, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussions with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.

Terms of payment will be Net 30 days after the receipt of a proper invoice. A proper invoice must contain:

- (i) Name and address of the Contractor;
- (ii) Invoice date and number;
- (iii) Contract number, contract line item number and, if applicable, the order number;
- (iv) Description, quantity, unit of measure, unit price and extended price of the items delivered;
- (vi) Terms of any discount for prompt payment offered;
- (vii) Name, title, and phone number of person to notify in event of defective invoice; and
- (viii) Electronic funds transfer (EFT) banking information.

Details of the Project

Construction of a turning lane at the northwest corner of the US Consulate on Jada-e-Mawlana Jaluladin Road. The contractor is required to demolish, remove and dispose of the existing median barrier between traffic lanes. The contractor will make clean, saw-cut joints on existing infrastructure, excavate, remove, and dispose of the existing material to a depth sufficient to place 150 mm of gravel road base compacted to 95% relative density. The contractor will place, compact, and finish 150 mm of road mix asphalt and finish the work level with the adjacent roadway. The work must meet the same standards as the current road. The finished product should resemble the existing median, curb, and paved road in all aspects. Attached are the conceptual drawings for estimation of price.
