Undergraduate Application Timeline

Grade 9

- Select academically challenging courses for grades 10 -12 & prepare to work hard!
- Discuss your goals with your family
- Get involved in at least 1 or 2 community/extra-curricular activities throughout high school

Grade 11: June/July

- Attend a "Study in the USA" Information Session/visit www.educationusa.info
- Note admission test dates & registration deadlines
- Begin preparing for admission tests
- Start researching universities: www.petersons.com & www.collegeboard.com
- Apply for South African I.D.

Grade 11: November - Grade 12: May

- Prepare for and take admission tests
- Apply for South African Passport

Grade 12: June and July

- Finalize list of colleges (3 – 10)
- Make a list of application deadlines
- Work on admission essays
- Complete university applications.

Grade 12: July - November

- Complete International Student Financial Aid/Scholarship Forms with your family
- Request all necessary official report forms, recommendations, and grade reports from your school.
- Re-take admission tests if necessary
- Submit applications

Grade 12: December – August

- Receive acceptances/denials, & respond
- Attend pre-departure orientation
- Apply for student visa & Fly!

U.S. University Post-Grad Application Timeline

At Current University

- Take academically challenging courses & study hard!
- Get to know some professors
- Gain research/work experience
- Plan to complete a four year degree, or 3 year degree plus an Honours year to be eligible for admission into US Master's and PhD programs

18 Months before U.S. University Start Date

- Attend a "Study in the USA" Information Session & visit www.educationusa.info
- Begin preparing for admission tests
- Start researching professors & universities i.e.: www.petersons.com

16 Months Before

- Register, prepare for and take admission tests
- Contact U.S. University departments/professors regarding questions not answered on their websites

12 Months Before

- Finalize list of Universities (5 or so)
- Make a note of application deadlines
- Complete application forms
- Request official university transcripts & recommendations from your university
- Work on Statement of Purpose
- Apply for South African Passport

10 Months Before

- Complete International Student Financial Aid/Scholarship Forms
- Re-take admission tests if necessary
- Submit applications

6 - 0 Months Before

- Receive acceptances/denials & respond
- Attend pre-departure orientation
- Apply for student visa & Fly!
