**Please note that the application deadline is Sunday September 30th, 2012.** Completed applications and passport copies **MUST** be submitted by this time in order to be considered for the conference. Some students may not have up-to-date passports – please ensure that they sort these issues out **BEFORE** applying to the conference. All applicants will learn of their acceptance status within two weeks of the deadline.

## **PROGRAM**

Our MUN conference is a forum for engaged high school students to debate current global issues and gain insight into the world of international politics and decision-making. The 2013 program will include Opening and Closing Ceremonies, six Committee Sessions, Expert Debriefs, a Diplomatic Lunch, a Cultural Night, and a visit to Education City, home of Qatar Foundation and six major American universities, including the Georgetown University School of Foreign Service in Qatar. ## **FEE INFORMATION**

Attendance to this program will be **fully funded by the American Embassy in Algiers and Georgetown University in Doha for a team of six students and one adult advisor.** This funding will cover air travel, airport transfers in Doha to/from the hotel, hotel accommodation, two meals a day, and conference activities.
