



## **The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program 2016**

The Humphrey Fellowship Program is U.S. Department of State sponsored program that provides young and mid-career professionals Algeria with an opportunity to enhance their professional capacities through participation in specialized 10-month non-degree programs developed specifically for small clusters of Humphrey Fellows at selected U.S. universities.

During their year-long stay at a host American university, Humphrey Fellows are invited to take graduate courses relevant to their professional interests. However, as the Humphrey Fellowship is not a degree program, participants spend a considerable portion of their time engaged in professional development activities including consultations with U.S. faculty and experts, field trips, workshops, research projects, and the development of practical useful strategies that could be applied in the Fellows' home countries.

Applicants must hold a License degree, have five years of substantial professional experience, and demonstrate proficiency in English by scoring at least a 71 on the TOEFL iBT test.
