



## ALGERIAN YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM SUMMER 2014

Secondary school students and educators from Algeria are invited to apply for participation in the Youth Leadership Program with Algeria. The four-week U.S.-based exchange program, tentatively scheduled for June 12 – July 8, 2014, will focus on the primary themes of civic education, youth leadership development, respect for diversity, and community engagement, and the sub-theme of applied communications. Participants will engage in a variety of activities, such as workshops on leadership and service, community site visits related to the program themes, interactive training and discussion groups, small group work, presentations, local cultural activities, homestays with American families, and other activities. This is an intensive program with three segments: A pre-departure orientation in Algiers; a four-week program in Reno, Nevada that will offer 24 students and three educators the opportunity to explore the principles of leadership and community engagement in the United States; and follow-on activities, where participants will conduct projects in their home communities. The program will be intensive, academic, and highly interactive. The program sponsors seek energetic applicants who are ready to develop their skills in order to be effective leaders in their schools and communities.
