Catering requirements:

BBQ will be provided; vendor must provide charcoal and all other supplies.

Hamburgers – charcoal grilled. American-style: Pure, high-quality beef, sliced cheddar cheese, lettuce, tomatoes, onions only (no eggs, no other toppings). Simple hamburger buns that are not as thick and bready as Portuguese rolls and don't fall apart. Condiments on the side: ketchup, mustard, and mayonnaise.

Ribs – BBQ, served individually.

Side dishes – Cabbage cole slaw and potato salad

Beer, red and white wine & sodas: Coke, light or zero, sprite.

Services:

Service of all food

Passed (waiter)services of all beverage items.

Charcoal grilling up to 200 Burgers and Ribs.

Service of all food and beverage items.

Set up and tear down of two or three grilling and service stations.

Set up and tear down of two or three beverage stations.

Provide sufficient trash receptacles for guests' trash

Removal of all debris and trash created by the caterer. Clean up of kitchen afterwards if vendor uses the Embassy's kitchen

***Caterers will have to provide names, date of birth, place of birth and national identification numbers for all employees who will be working at the event. Information must be provided two weeks before the event.

*** The U.S Embassy Luanda will not advance payment for the event. The invoice will be paid by EFT in full after good conclusion of services. The Embassy can pay in US dollars or Kwanza at the vendor's choice.

This requirement will be open to proposals during 20 days from the date of the announcement on March 6, 2016
