



Exhibit Layout

- The US exhibit at Tecnópolis will showcase the joint U.S.-Argentine SAC-D/Aquarius satellite program which has allowed scientists to investigate the impact of climate change on the earth.
- Visitors will see various images of Earth – from the famous blue marble collection (which is the most detailed true-color images of the entire Earth to date) to images from the SAC-D/Aquarius satellite.



 - High resolution printing – 720 dpi




