This scholarship is open to Australian citizens who are junior/middle level professionals from the public, private and academic sectors, for research into contemporary aspects of the Australian–United States alliance (defence/security), and broader bi-national relations (trade/economics/politics) of interest to both alliance partners.

The Fulbright Professional Scholarship in Australian-U.S. Alliance Studies, sponsored by DFAT was established in 2001 by Australia's Minister for Foreign Affairs as a portfolio contribution to Australia's ANZUS 50th Anniversary commemorations. The scholarship aim to contribute in a practical way to contemporary Australian scholarship on the Australia-US alliance relationship.

The program of study can commence between 1 July 2012 and 30 June 2013, with a preference for the scholarship to be undertaken at the Center for Australian & NZ Studies at Georgetown University, in Washington DC, or at the Center for Australian & NZ Studies at The University of Texas at Austin.
