To undertake a 3-4 month research or study program in the United States
Valued at USD 30,000

This scholarship is for an Australian citizen who works in the vocational education and training sector, or is a training leader in business and industry.

It is open to:

- Employees, including teachers, managers, and administrators, or private and public registered training organisations.
- People who are leading vocational education and training strategies within their business.

The program can commence any time between 1 July 2012 and the 30 June 2013.

Preference will be given to those who have a record of achievement and are poised for advancement to senior levels.

The program undertaken should concern current vocational education and training policy or practice and must include an educational component (such as a short-course and/or research) that may involve other forms of professional experience, including visits to relevant organisations.

The Fulbright VET Scholar is expected to share their research and experiences through conferences, presentations and publications before and/or after their Fulbright program.

Fulbright Scholarships also include:

- Enrichment Seminars in the United States with international Fulbright Scholars
- Distinguished professional network with U.S. and Australian Fulbright Alumni Associations
- A support agency in the U.S. that assists with visas, events, and networks
