This act of crime has deeply hurt our feelings and has insulted the values of humanity and of our tradition, particularly, the values of friendship that our people have preserved and cultivate towards the American people.

Many students and youngsters from Kosova, including those living abroad, have experienced the horror of war in Kosovo. Moreover, the help that came from the U.S.A and its soldiers, helping a nation from vanishing and facilitating a better future for all in Kosovo, will remain significant and unforgettable.

For this, without any hesitation and reserve, the whole Albanian nation and we are grateful and thankful.


Convinced that this act of crime represents an individual case of extreme manipulation, we welcome and support any commitment to clarify the case and give the deserved sentence to the actors responsible.
