

Dr. Earl H. Fry is Professor of Political Science and Endowed Professor of Canadian Studies at Brigham Young University. He has previously served as a Visiting Lecturer at the Sorbonne, Director of International Education and Canadian Studies at SUNY Plattsburgh, a Council on Foreign Relations International Affairs Fellow, and Special Assistant in the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR), part of the Executive Office of the President of the United States, among others.

Professor Fry is the author of numerous books on international trade and investment as well as on U.S. foreign policy including *Lament for America: Decline of the Superpower*; *Plan for Renewal*; *Financial Invasion of the U.S.A.*; and *North American Economic Integration: Policy Options*.
