She has published over 100 academic articles and chapters in books and is the author or editor of nine books. Recent publications include *Democracy in Europe* (Oxford 2006), *The Futures of European Capitalism* (Oxford 2002), *Welfare and Work in the Open Economy* (2 vols, co-ed. with F. W. Scharpf, Oxford 2000), *Discursive Institutionalism: The Explanatory Power of Ideas and Discourse*, *Annual Review of Political Science* (2008), and *Putting the Political Back into Political Economy by Bringing the State Back in Yet Again*, *World Politics* (2009). Recent awards and distinctions include an honorary doctorate (doctor honoris causa) from the Free University of Brussels (ULB) (2008); the Franqui Interuniversity Chair, Belgium (2007); Visiting Researcher at CEVIPOF, Sciences Po, Paris (2007). She is past head of the European Union Studies Association-USA and has consulted widely in the US and Europe on issues related to European government, business and US-EU relations.*
