



The American Embassy is accepting applications for the following position:

### **Executive Bodyguard**

Incumbent serves as Executive Bodyguard for the Chief of Mission (COM). Protects the COM port-to-portal from the threat of terrorism or other acts of violence. While with the COM, the bodyguard will take extraordinary and/or special security precautions to insure the personal safety of the COM. The bodyguard will assist in the selection of safe routes and remain alert for danger of the COM.

Interested candidates are required to possess the following skills and qualifications:

- **Education:** Completion of high school required. Royal Bahamas Police Force College or Royal Bahamas Defense Force training or U.S. Military or U.S. law enforcement experience is required.
- **Experience:** Two – three years of Police experience in Police, Defense Force law enforcement, or specialized security is required.
- **Skills:** Must have the ability to be trained in the use of various firearms. Maintain proficiency in the use of firearms. Be in excellent physical condition. Be able to deal with officials in a diplomatic manner. Must have a valid driver's license. Must be courteous, discreet, and tactful at all times. Must be able to coordinate movements and routes with COM chauffeur. Must have the ability to determine the fastest and safest route in an emergency situation. Must be flexible and able to adjust to rapid and unexpected schedule changes. Must be able to work independently with a minimum of supervision. Must have good problem solving skills.
- **Knowledge:** Must be familiar with the City of Nassau, Freeport, and the Out Islands in The Bahamas. Knowledge of historical and current events that could affect the security of the protectee.
- **Language:** English level IV (fluent) both written and spoken.
