From government and private schools

The Tomorrow's Leaders Scholarship Program is a U.S. Department of State Middle East Partnership Initiative (MEPI) initiative for capable and highly motivated high school seniors in the Middle East and North Africa from underserved backgrounds. The scholarship includes: travel, academic fees for four years of university at the **American University of Beirut**, the **American University in Cairo**, and the **Lebanese American University**, accident and sickness insurance, housing, and a monthly allowance.

SELECTED CANDIDATES OF THIS PROGRAM WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO:

- Pursue an undergraduate degree in Lebanon or Egypt at an American university
- Participate in a fully funded four year academic program
- Enhance leadership skills and increase spirit of civic engagement and volunteerism

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Current high school senior or applicant who graduated from high school in 2013;
- Citizen or national of Bahrain, or those qualified to hold a Bahraini passport;
- Strong academic credentials;
- Proficiency in written and spoken English with a minimum Institutional TOEFL (ITP) score of 490 (or equivalent on a similar test) that is less than two years old [**The TOEFL [ITP] exam will be arranged by AMIDEAST if you qualify for the program**]
- Maturity, flexibility and leadership potential;
- Ability to start the program in August/September of 2014.

Note: American citizens are not eligible
