



Announcement: Community Solutions Program 2013-2014

The American Center of the U.S. Embassy Dhaka is happy to announce that applications for the Community Solutions Program for 2013-2014 are now open. The Community Solutions Program is a program of the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs of the U.S. Department of State, and implemented by IREX. This will be the third round of the [Community Solutions Program](#), a professional development program for the best and brightest global community leaders working in Transparency & Accountability, Tolerance & Conflict Resolution, Environmental Issues, and Women & Gender Issues.

Selected candidates will participate in: a four month U.S. fellowship with a local nonprofit organization or government agency; structured virtual learning and networking via the Online Community Leadership Institute; and, the design and implementation of follow-on projects in their home countries. The program will also include a small outbound component that will allow up to five U.S. host representatives to travel overseas for approximately two weeks on projects related to the program themes.

Citizens from Bangladesh are eligible to participate in the Community Solutions Program.
