



# U.S. Visa Interview Waiver program

Effective from January 06, 2013, to determine whether you may be eligible to renew your non-immigrant B1/B2 visa without appearing for an interview, the following criteria must be met:

**Yes**   **No**

- I have a previous U.S. B1/B2 visa.
- My previous B1/B2 visa was issued in Dhaka, Bangladesh, on or after January 1, 2008;
- My B1/B2 visa is still valid or expired within the last 12 months;
- I have had no refusals for a visa in any category after my most recent visa issuance;
- My previous visa has never been revoked, lost, or stolen;
- My name, date of birth, nationality, and place of birth are same on both B1/B2 applications (current and previous)
- My prior B1/B2 visa does NOT have the annotation "Clearance Received."
- On my previous visit to the United States, I complied with all immigration laws and regulations.

If you have selected "Yes" to all the questions above, you may be eligible for a visa renewal/re-issuance without a personal interview. You may submit for visa renewals with the following documents to Saimon Overseas, our implementing partner:

1. Original Passports (old passports to be attached if you have the previous U.S visa pasted on it)
2. DS-160 nonimmigrant visa application confirmation sheet
3. Original \$160 MRV fee receipt for the visa processing
4. Taka 575 as service charges for scheduling. You may need to pay other service charges if Saimon assists you to complete the DS-160 or if the MRV fee is paid at Saimon. See our website for more detail about service fees
5. One photograph with a white background, 2 x 2 inches (51 x 51 mm) in size. Specifications for the photograph are available on the Embassy web site <http://www.dhaka.usembassy.gov>

Note that eligibility for interview waiver does not guarantee a visa issuance nor does it guarantee that an interview will be waived. Although your visa interview may be waived, you may still be required to appear for fingerscanning. Any necessary notification will be made via the email address listed in your DS 160 online applicant. See sample below.
