



U.S. Visa Interview Waiver Program

To determine whether you may be eligible to renew your non-immigrant visa without appearing for an interview, look at your previous visa and answer yes to the statements below (by visa category):

- I am renewing a B, C1/D, F, M, or J visa;
 - I am citizen or resident of Bangladesh and currently present in Bangladesh;
 - My visa was issued in Dhaka on or after January 1, 2008;
 - My visa is still valid or has expired within the last 12 months;
 - My age was over 14 when my previous visa was issued;
 - I have had no refusals for a visa in any category after my most recent visa issuance;
 - My previous visa has never been revoked, lost, or stolen;
 - My name, date of birth, nationality, and place of birth are the same on both applications (current and previous);
 - On my previous visit to the United States, I complied with all immigration laws and regulations;
- For principal F, M, or J visa holders only:**
- I am returning to the same institution and I did not drop out of status for 5 months or more. (This also includes derivatives.)

If you answered **yes** to the statements above (by visa category), you qualify for interview waiver. Please provide Saimon Overseas with the following:

- Your current passport that has a validity of at least six months beyond your intended stay in the U.S. (B, C1/D, F, M, and J)
- The DS-160 nonimmigrant visa application confirmation sheet (B, C1/D, F, M, and J)
- Original MRV fee receipt for the visa processing (B, C1/D, F, M, and J)
- One photograph with a white background, 2 x 2 inches (B, C1/D, F, M, and J)
- Copy of I-20 or DS-2019 (principal F, M, J)
- Copy of F, M, J dependents' I-20 or DS-2019
- Copy of your CDC book/employment contract (for C1/D)

Important: Please note that eligibility for interview waiver does not guarantee a visa issuance nor does it guarantee that the interview will be waived. Although your interview may be waived, you may still be required to appear for finger scanning. Any necessary notification will be made via the email address listed in your DS-160 online application.
