2. The auction will run from May **15, 2014** through May **29, 2014 at 5:00 PM local time**.
3. Items will be sold “AS IS” with no guarantee.
4. **All the items in this auction form one single lot. Each bid is for all the items.**

15. Winner is responsible for transporting property off Embassy compound immediately after payment.
