Lost or Stolen Green Cards

Q: What do I do if my green card is lost or stolen?

A: If your green card is lost or stolen, you will need to apply for a boarding foil before you can return to the United States. In order to apply for a boarding foil, write to BridgetownIV@state.gov. We will give you an appointment to appear at the Embassy in Bridgetown. When you come to your appointment, be sure to bring:

- Your valid passport
- A copy of your green card (if available)
- Evidence of your most recent departure from the United States
- A recent passport sized photo of yourself
- A police report documenting when and where your green card was lost or stolen
- Completed Form I-90: Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card

Please note that it typically takes at least two business days to process a boarding foil request from the time of your appointment.
