The American Citizens Services Consul and staff from the U.S. Consulate in Barcelona will visit Andorra on Saturday, July 28 to process applications for renewal /replacement of U.S. passports (adult and minors).

The Consular Officer will be available at the Centre de Congressos d'Andorra la Vella, Sala AQUA, from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm.

Persons who require passport services need to contact the Consulate's American Citizens Services Unit in advance (barcelonaacs@state.gov; and/or Tel. 93 280 22 27) to reserve a space and to find out what supporting documents and photographs they should bring and what statutory fees are applicable. Please also bring both the original and photocopies of your documents. IMPORTANT INFORMATION: New absentee voting laws are in effect for the 2012 elections. You may no longer automatically receive ballots based on a previous absentee ballot request. All U.S. citizens outside the United States who want to vote by absentee ballot in U.S. elections should complete a new Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) every year. States are now required to send out ballots 45 days before an election. No matter what State you vote in, you can now ask your local election officials to provide your blank ballots to

you electronically (by email, internet download, or fax, depending on your State). You can now also confirm your registration and ballot delivery online. Be sure to include your email address on the form to take advantage of the electronic ballot delivery option. This is the fastest and most reliable way to receive your ballot on time, and we strongly recommend every voter take advantage of it.
