The Embassy of the United States of America is selling a satellite dish. There is no minimum bid for this item.

Interested bidders should complete and return the Bid Form (included in this advertisement) to [BelmopanGSO@state.gov](mailto:BelmopanGSO@state.gov) no later than 12 pm December 21st, 2015. The winning bidder will be contacted by 5 pm on December 21st, 2015 and arrangements will be made for payment and pickup.

Full payment shall be made in Belize Dollars within 24 hours. The U.S. Embassy shall not accept checks or any other currency. The container must be removed by 5pm on December 28th, 2015. Item will be sold "as-is" with no guarantee or returns.

\*\*\* All interested bidders must be 18 years or older and will be required to show a valid (picture) identification card matching the information on the Bid Form on the day of the payment.

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## SALE RULES

All persons wishing to participate must be at least 18 years old and must show proof of age with a valid picture I.D. upon payment. Information on ID should match the information on the Bid Form.

Each bidder must return the "Bid Form" where the bidder will register his bids and sign an acknowledgement accepting the rules of the auction.

After completing the Bid Form, the bidder must send the completed form to [BelmopanGSO@state.gov](mailto:BelmopanGSO@state.gov) by 12 pm on December 21st, 2015.

Only concrete amounts (i.e. 100.01 dollars) are allowed. (Not allowed: i.e. 5 dollars more than highest bid.)

Once the bid form is received, it can neither be altered nor returned.

On December 21st, 2015, at 1 pm, the Embassy will review all bids and rank them in order of the highest to the lowest.

The Embassy will then inform by telephone the highest bidder. The highest bidder must come to the Embassy within 24 hours to pay for the item in full by cash or cashier's check. The winning bidder must collect his items no later than December 28th, 2015, by close of business (5 PM).

In the event of a tie, a coin flip will determine the winner.

The Winning bidder who declines and/or fails to come and pay for the item will forfeit their claim on the item and the Embassy will then proceed to call the second highest bidder, and so on, until an actual bidder pays for the item.

Payment will be made to the American Embassy in Belize dollars (cash) or certified check only. (No US cash will be accepted).

Upon payment, Embassy personnel will assist and instruct the winner on the procedures to remove the purchased item(s) from the auction grounds as items may not/not be stored on the Embassy's grounds. The USG has special procedures for allowing access to vehicles and cranes into its compound and only after the proper paperwork and authorizations have been requested and approved may the winning bidder be allowed to enter the compound.

Items will be sold on a "NO GUARANTEE", "AS IS" basis.

Buyer shall be responsible for paying all applicable duties and taxes. Proof of payment of customs and taxes must be provided before item is released to the buyer.

The Embassy reserves the right to accept or decline any or all of the bids on any lot or from any bidder.
