5. Supervising Institution
6. Previous activities
7. Possible sustainability (?)
8. Project Site(s)

Page Two and Three: Summary

1. Program Description: Describe the program summary to be undertaken. Include information on incidence or prevalence and severity of the problem in children. Describe what is not known about the problem that



- the proposal intends to address. Include any preliminary information about how your program differs from others
2. Program summary: Describe the precise objective(s) of the program. State the specific program indicators to be undertaken and the primary outcomes and; how they will be measured.
 3. Rationale: Indicate why you have adopted the particular approach of your program.
 4. Program Logistics: Discuss ways and in which potentially influence/address youth vulnerability
