For example, candidates for this track could include: a Program Manager for a youth development NGO who is in a position of influence to strengthen the content and pedagogy used to develop soft skills amongst unemployed youth; a member of the HR team in a company who can introduce a mentorship program that helps new employees to develop the necessary competencies to succeed in the workplace; a government employee who can provide input to policy decisions that equip youth with the skills they need in the workplace and encourage active participation from the private sector in this effort.
