### E-Teacher Program Description:

The E-Teacher Scholarship Program offers online, university-level classes to English teaching professionals outside of the United States through a U.S. university partner. Currently E-Teacher 10-week online courses are offered for the following terms:

- Winter 2014: January 6 – March 14
- Spring 2014: April 7 – June 13
- Summer 2014: June 23 – August 29, 2013

Nominations are made by U.S. embassies and consulates. If you are selected, all costs are paid by the U.S. Department of State.
