1. Prospective bidders must pay a refundable deposit of 100,000 Kyats and buy a bid form for 1,000 Kyats prior to bidding. All bid amounts must be in FEC.
2. For Sale I, the generator will be displayed at #110 University Ave Compound, Yangon. All bids must be submitted by 12:00 noon on Friday, Mar 29, 2013. Bids received after 12:00 noon on Friday, Mar 29, 2013 will be disqualified.
3. For sale part II, property will be displayed at #140 University Ave Compound, Yangon. All bids must be submitted by 12:00 noon on Saturday, Mar 30, 2013. Bids received after 12:00 noon on Saturday, Mar 30, 2013 will be disqualified.
4. The winning bidders will be announced at 01:00 pm on Monday, April 1, 2013 at #140 University Ave Compound, Yangon. Winning bidders have to collect the documents for customs at #110, University Avenue, Kamaryut Township, Yangon. (Contact person Myint Than Ext 4115)
