2. For Sale part I, the printing machine and associated items will be displayed at #110 University Ave compound, Yangon. All bids must be submitted by 12:00 noon on Friday, December 20, 2013. Bids received after 12:00 noon on Friday, December 20, 2013 will be disqualified.
3. For Sale part II, property will be displayed at #140 University Ave Compound, Yangon. All bids must be submitted by 12:00 noon on Saturday, December 21, 2013. Bids received after 12:00 noon on Saturday, December 21, 2013 will be disqualified.
