1. Prospective bidders must pay a refundable deposit of 100,000 Kyats and buy a bid form for 1,000 Kyats prior to bidding. All bid amounts must be in FEC.
2. Property will be displayed at #140, University Avenue, Kamaryut, Yangon. All bids must be submitted by 12:00 noon on Saturday, Jan 29, 2011. Bids received after 12:00 noon on Saturday, Jan 29, 2011 will be disqualified. The winning bidders will be announced **on Monday, Jan 31, 2011, 01:00 p.m.** at above location.
3. Winning bidders must:
 - Receive paperwork at Sale Site #140, University Avenue, Kamaryut Township, Yangon from Feb 1 and 2, 2011 between 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
 - Pay if required any customs duty to Department of Customs and be prepared to show their customs receipt.
 - **Make payments in FEC** for all winning items directly to the GSO cashier on **Feb 1, 2011 between 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** and **Feb 2, 2011 between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon** at Sale Site #140, University Avenue, Kamaryut Township. **Winning bidders who have not made their payments to the cashier by Feb 2, 2011 at 12:00 noon will lose the winning lots and forfeit their deposits.**
4. Upon proof of payment of purchased price (and proof of customs payment where required), bidders may remove winning items from the sale site on Feb 1 through Feb 4, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
