# NCAGE CODE

- ◎ Use Internet Explorer for better results



# NCAGE CODE

- ⦿ All primary foreign entities are required to register in NCAGE
- ⦿ Are given a 5-character code (includes numbers and letters)
- ⦿ Takes 4-5 business days to process
- ⦿ Can begin the registration in NCAGE while waiting for the D&B DUNS number

# NCAGE CODE

- ◎ Legal Business Name and Address must match the information entered in D&B DUNS
  - If punctuation, spelling, or other is different from when inputting data into the systems, (D&B DUNS, NCAGE, and SAM)
    - Registration in SAM will fail
  - If unsuccessful in SAM, follow instructions provided, which may indicate that you do not have a D&B DUNS number or NCAGE Code, or information does not match exactly

# GETTING INTO NCAGE

You may perform a wildcard search on a company name by placing a "?" after the name. BINCS will search by each individual word (up to three words). Example: WOOD WORKING? partial company name must contain at least 3 characters in addition to the "?" The company name field will ignore common words such as "the" and "and." Example: ASP?

The phone number must contain at least 6 digits. The phone number field must include the area code and the exchange code. Example: 616555

When entering Company or SIC you may further narrow the search by selecting the corresponding state field. Searching by the state alone does not constitute valid search criteria.

NOTE: Using partial searches will increase processing time and may time out the page.
