### INSTRUCTIONS FOR FIANCE(E) NONIMMIGRANT VISA APPLICANTS

This office has received a petition entitling you to "K1" nonimmigrant visa classification as an alien proceeding to the United States to marry an American citizen. To prepare for your interview appointment with a consular officer, please read and follow carefully the following instructions:

**FIRST:** Complete and return by mailing immediately to this office the enclosed

- **DS-160** confirmation page. To fill out the DS-160, please go to [http://travel.state.gov/visa/forms/forms\\_4230.html](http://travel.state.gov/visa/forms/forms_4230.html)
- **Form I-134** (Affidavit of support).  
Can be downloaded from <http://www.uscis.gov/I-134>
- **Optional Form 169 for K1**

This office cannot process your case until these forms are received.

**SECOND:** Obtain the following documents on this checklist which pertain to you and present them to the consular officer on the interview date. **Do NOT send** them to this office.

- 1. **PASSPORTS:** A Passport must be valid for travel to the United States and must have at least **six months** validity beyond the issuance date of the visa. Children must have their own passports regardless of any age.
- 2. **BIRTH CERTIFICATES:** You are required to present an original and a copy of your birth certificate.
- 3. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** Two (2x2 inches or 5x5 cm) frontal view with white background photographs are required.

- 4. **A CERTIFICATE OF LEGAL CAPACITY TO MARRY:** Fiancé(e) visa applicants are required to have a certificate issued by the Commune Council with jurisdiction over the area in which they reside certifying the applicant's eligibility to marry.
- 5. **MARRIAGE ANNULMENT:** Proof of the termination of any previous marriage must be submitted (e.g. death certificate of spouse, final decree of divorce or annulment).

**6. EVIDENCE OF RELATIONSHIP:** You should bring with you evidence to establish the relationship between you and the petitioner. Examples of evidence of relationship may include, but is not limited to, letters, photographs, or other evidence of your relationship to the petitioner.

**7. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:** All intending immigrants, regardless of age, are required to complete a medical examination.

**8. POLICE CERTIFICATES/RECORDS:** Each visa applicant aged 16 years or over is required to submit a police certificate from the police authorities of each locality of the country of the applicant's nationality or current residence where the applicant has resided for at least six months since attaining the age of sixteen. Police certificates are also required from all other countries where the applicant has resided for at least one year. A police certificate must also be obtained from the police authorities of any place where the applicant has been arrested for any reason, regardless of how long he or she lived there. Police certificates must cover the entire period of the applicant's residence in any area. A certificate issued by the police authorities where you now reside must be of recent date when presented to the consular officer. The term "police certificate" as used in this paragraph means a certification by appropriate police authorities stating what their records show concerning each applicant, including all arrests, the reasons for the arrests, and the disposition of each case of which there is a record. **In Cambodia**, the police certificate is issued by the Ministry of Justice at No 240, Sothearos Blvd, Phnom Penh. **9. MILITARY RECORDS:** A copy of a military record is required from your office or department if you are or used to be military personnel. The military records must contain a complete record of the applicant's service and conduct while in the service. The record must show any convictions of crime before military tribunals.

**10. COURT AND PRISON RECORDS:** Persons convicted of a crime must obtain a certified copy of each court record and any prison record, regardless of the fact that they may have benefited subsequently from an amnesty, pardon, or other act of clemency.

**11. TRANSLATIONS:** Any foreign language document must be accompanied by a full English translation that the translator has certified as complete and correct, and by the translator's certification that he or she is competent to translate the foreign language into English.

#### **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT CAREFULLY**

**THIRD:** As soon as you have obtained all of documents that apply to your case, carefully read the statement at the bottom of this page, sign and date it, and return the form to this office. You will not be scheduled for an appointment until you sign and return this checklist. After this form has been returned to this office, you will be scheduled for a visa interview at the earliest possible date. Each applicant must be prepared to pay the application fee on the appointment date. For visa application fees, please go to <http://travel.state.gov> . Payment must be made in US currency cash only.

You need not check with this office unless you have to report a CHANGE OF ADDRESS or change in your situation such as marriage, death of petitioner, or birth of children. Please do not send any documents to this office unless you are specifically requested to do so.

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I have in my possession and am prepared to present all the documents listed in items 1 through 13 which apply to my case as indicated by the check mark I have placed in the appropriate boxes. I fully realize that no advance assurance can be given when or whether a visa will actually be issued to me and I also understand that I should NOT give up my job, dispose of property, or make any final travel arrangement until a visa is actually issued to me. At such time as it is possible for me to receive an appointment to make formal visa application I intended to apply. (Check appropriate box)
