The American Consulate General, Frankfurt hereby provides the following Pre-Solicitation Notice regarding the issuance of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for:

**Construction Services for PEPFAR Program, U.S. Embassy Yaoundé, Cameroon**

The work involves renovation/conversion of a warehouse building located in a compound owned by the Cameroon - Ministry of Public Health in Yaoundé to a National Public Health Laboratory. Renovation includes the entire removal and replacement of roof structure; removal of existing window frames and replacing them with new ones at designated locations; removal of existing floor and replacing it with a new one; installation of Concrete Masonry Unit (CMU) partitions; removal of existing plastering and installation of new plastering on existing walls and new partitions; painting; installation of new plumbing system; installation of new electrical system; installation of new mechanical system; installation of ceiling systems and installation of laboratory casework.

The solicitation may result in the award of a Firm-Fixed Price Construction Type Contract in fiscal year 2014. The estimated range for this project is between \$1,000,000.00 and \$5,000,000.00 U.S. Dollars for the entire project.

A pre-proposal conference and site visit shall be scheduled for end of May/ beginning of June 2014, detailed information shall be provided in the solicitation document.

Companies interested in the solicitation shall express their interest by written correspondence to the attention of Ms. Joanna Catsamaki at the above e-mail address, no later than May 21, 2014 using the solicitation number SGE500-14-R-0039 in the subject line. **DO NOT TELEPHONE**. All requests for a copy of the solicitation **MUST** include the following information: name of firm, name of contact person, telephone and fax numbers, and email address of Point of Contact and complete physical and mailing address of firm.

Firms shall be knowledgeable in written and spoken English and possess all appropriate permits and licenses to perform construction work in Cameroon. In conjunction with DOSAR 652.242.73 AUTHORIZATION AND PERFORMANCE (AUG 1999), requests for the solicitation package shall contain a statement that licensing and other requirements to perform work in Cameroon have been reviewed/researched prior to application. The solicitation package will only be available in the English language.

Solicitation and award will be subject to the laws and regulations of the United States of America and is being competed utilizing full and open competition procedures.
