2014-2015 SAT AND ACT TESTING IN ATLANTIC CANADA

U.S. colleges and universities generally require either SAT or ACT test scores when you apply. To decide whether to take the SAT or ACT test, check the entrance requirements on the websites of the U.S. schools you are interested in attending. Many schools will take either your SAT or ACT mark, so you might want to take a free practice exam (available on the respective websites) to see which test better suits your style.
