

**AMERICAN CITIZEN SERVICES AVAILABLE IN ST. JOHN'S, NL**  
**SEPTEMBER 12 & 13, 2013**

The U.S. Consulate General in Halifax is pleased to announce that a U.S. consular officer will be in St. John's, Newfoundland, September 12-13, 2013 to provide specific services for American citizens. This special trip is organized to assist U.S. citizens, residing in Newfoundland and Labrador, who on all other occasions must travel to Halifax for consular service.

The U.S. Consul will be available from 8:30 am - 12:00 noon and 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm on Thursday, September 12 and from 8:30 am – 11:00 am on Friday, September 13 to take applications for passports, birth registrations, acquisition of U.S. citizenship, or voter registration. Fees will only be taken in the form of money orders made out in U.S. dollars. No personal checks, cash, credit or debit cards will be accepted.

**Applicants for all services must bring original documents and one photocopy of each document.**
