October 31, 2012: Fresh from their performances for the United Nations in Geneva and, more recently, for American Veterans (the latter concert was taped live last week in Orlando, Florida, home of Disney World), the internationally renowned **MMG Symphony Orchestra and Chorale** will present **A Canadian-American Friendship Concert**. It is part of their "Healing for the Nations" series. It will celebrate **Remembrance Day**, and honour Canadian veterans.
