



How to apply for a U.S. Nonimmigrant Visa

You should follow the step-by-step instructions below to apply for a U.S. Nonimmigrant Visa, pay your visa fee, and schedule a visa interview appointment at the U.S. Consulate General in Chiang Mai.

Please note that the instructions below do NOT apply if you are applying for a Fiancé visa (K).



1. Go to www.ustraveldocs.com/th. Review the general information on how to apply for a U.S. visa and the requirements for each visa category.
2. Complete the DS-160 online application form (each individual requires his/her separate DS-160.) You will need to print out the DS-160 confirmation page after you have submitted it online (required for the interview).
3. Create your profile using your personal email address on www.ustraveldocs.com/th.
4. Be sure to supply all the required personal information: your passport number, name, date of birth, visa type, DS-160 application ID, etc. Please note that your name **MUST** be exactly the same as it is written in your passport and you must include all other names you have used in the past.
5. Pay for the visa fee in Thai baht either by Electronic Fund Transfer **or** in cash directly at a Krungsri Bank branch. If you pay cash, you **MUST** print your **CGI Cash deposit slip** and bring it with you to the bank – without this slip, the bank will not accept the fee.
6. Once the fee has been paid, you will receive an email from the system after 12:00 of the following business day (if paid by cash) or in two business days (if paid via online banking) notifying you that the system is ready to schedule your appointment. You should log back in to your profile and schedule an interview at any available time.
7. After you schedule your interview appointment, print your appointment confirmation page (required for the interview).
8. Come to the Consulate for an interview. You will need the following documents:
 - a. Appointment confirmation letter
 - b. DS-160 confirmation page
 - c. Current and all previous passports
 - d. One visa photo (2X2 inches with white background)
 - e. Supporting evidence for your visa category, if any
