Payment for Consular Services Using Credit or Debit Cards

The U.S. Consulate General in Ciudad Juarez provides convenient and secure forms of payment for consular services clients, particularly for those completing medical examinations and/or submitting waiver applications. These methods of payment will decrease the vulnerability of those seeking consular services by reducing the amount of cash carried with them.
