Responsibilities and Requirements. When awarding a contract that requires Defense Base Act Insurance, the contracting officer must notify the successful offeror of the name of the insurance agent from which the contractor should acquire insurance. Please refer to DoSAR Subpart 628.3, Insurance. Contracts awarded overseas to non-United States firms who are not hiring U.S. citizens to work on their contracts are not required to include Defense Base Act clauses; however, FAR

52.228-4, Worker's Compensation and War Hazard Overseas (APR 1984), must be included in those contracts.

3. Section 5 - Representations and Certifications, FAR and DOSAR clauses on Defense Base Act are included in full text.

Defense Base Act clause (42 U.S.C 1651; FAR 28.305). "Contractor personnel" are U.S. citizens and U.S. residents, regardless of where they are when they are hired by the contractor. "Contractor personnel" also includes any local nationals and third country nationals hired by the contractor when those local nationals and/or third country nationals do not have worker's compensation laws in their countries. This policy applies to both U.S. and foreign firms.
