

Metallic Structure for Bus Roof Cover Construction at Santa Marta Synopsis
Solicitation SCO15016R0003

The U.S. Embassy, International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Section (INL) Bogotá has a requirement for the Construction of a metallic structure for the roof cover of a Bus for the Colombian National Police (CNP) at Santa Marta, Magdalena, Colombia.

The project consists of the construction of a metallic structure that shall support the roof cover, with its concrete foundation and chain link fence. The project includes excavations, filling material, reinforced concrete structures, metallic structures, roof tiles, chain link fence and accessories, as well as the grounding and atmospheric protection system. The offeror shall take into account the necessary logistic arrangements for the transportation of all the materials for the reinforced concrete structures, metallic elements for the structure and protection elements to the project site.

Place of Performance: Counternarcotic Police Base Facilities at Santa Marta (Magdalena), Colombia. Santa Marta is located at the Caribbean region and is the capital of the Magdalena department, which can be easily accessed through road. The average temperature is approx 27 °C, the elevation 2 m. above the sea level (6.56 ft) and it is bounded by the Caribbean Sea.
