

## **APIAY QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS (AS PER SITE VISIT) 09-29-14**

1. Are you going to change the external light on the trailer? **No**
2. Are you going to paint the bases of trailers? **No**
3. Are you going to move the base too? **No—contractor shall install new concrete support blocks**
4. Are you going to replace the door knob on the door of the trailer that is not moved and is in bad condition? **No**
5. Will the windows remain the same? **Yes**
6. Are you going to replace electrical ducts? **No**
7. Are you going to replace/repair the lower exterior siding on the trailer which is not moved, due to its bad state? **Yes—the bathroom trailer remaining at the south ramp will also be painted. The PWS will be updated to reflect the change.**
8. Is it the cover of the roof going to remain the same? **Yes**

### **ABOUT TRAILER THAT IS MOVED**

1. Is it the responsibility of the contractor the transfer of the trailer to TSCIF area? **Yes**
2. Where is the sewage and potable water located on base? **Contractor is required to coordinate with the CACOM 2 Public Works/Engineers for hook up locations and distances.**
3. The base should be done as the trailers that are in south ramp? **Yes—Equal or better**
4. Will you need ground wire replaced/repared? **Yes --part of electrical connection**
5. Will the bases be in concrete material? **Yes**
6. Do you need a tank of water for the bathroom? **No**
7. Do you know the diameter of the water line, sewage line? **Standard size in accordance with Colombian building codes**
8. Are you going to do a wastewater inspection box of 60 x 60 cm with lid concrete material? **No**
9. Will the air conditioners also be moved? **Yes as specified in the Performance Work Statement. Contractor shall be responsible for disconnecting, reconnecting and recharging with Freon.**

### **2.4 REFURBISH INTERIOR OF SIX OFFICE TRAILERS**

1. Is it necessary to replace the lights? **Yes as specified in the performance work statement**
2. Are you going to change the thermo acoustic roofing? **Yes for the trailers in the TSCIF area**
3. Are you going to change the windows? **No**

4. Is it necessary to repair/replace the floor even though it is in good condition? **Yes**
5. Who is in charge of payments? **US MILGP Contracting**
6. Do you need door knobs changed? **No**
7. How will payments be made? **Specified by US MILGP Contracting at the time of award.**

## **2.6 REPAIR/REPLACE OVERHEAD ROOF**

1. we need a more cleaner (clearer) and precise description of work wanted for the roof. **The performance work location will be changed from the lower 40 to replace the overhead roof panels at the TSCIF area. Panel shall include roofing over the TSCIF Trailer, Weather trailer and CI Trailer. The contractor shall use care as not to further damage panels and all removed panels from existing overhead roofing shall remain US Government property.**
