

Tumaco Jungla Camp Synopsis

The U.S. Embassy, Narcotics Affairs Section (NAS) Bogotá has a requirement for the construction of a Jungla Base Camp in Tumaco, Nariño.

The project consists of the supply and installation of metal barrier-based defense system structures for two 24 Man Bunker Lodging Facilities (lodging total for 48 men). The project includes defensive metal wall barriers, safety and protective elements, connection to public power, water supply and septic system, and water purification system.

Place of Performance: Colombian National Police (CNP) Facilities at the Tumaco airport (Nariño), Colombia. Tumaco is located in the southwest part of the Colombian territory along the pacific coast. It is located 300 km from San Juan de Pasto which the capital of the Nariño department and can be accessed through commercial flights and by road.
