b. The Government reserves the right to extend the notification deadline of the solicitation up to the date offers are initially due. The Government reserves the right to cancel this Request for Quote (RFQ) and make no award. By responding to this RFQ and submitting an offer in response to the RFQ, the Contractor understands that the Government shall not be liable for any costs incurred by the Contractor in response to this RFQ.

c. Offers submitted electronically via e-mail shall be prepared in Microsoft application programs (i.e., Word, Excel or pdf).

d. Volume I (Technical Offer) shall not exceed **10 pages total**, front and back (including attachments, appendices and addendums) and shall be limited to Arial or Times New Roman 12-point font size for all text, and a minimum of one inch margin on all four sides. Each paragraph shall be separated by at least one blank line. If the

page limit is exceeded, the pages in excess of the limit shall be removed and returned, unread, to the offeror. Specification sheets are not included in the page limit.

e. The Government will not accept any changes to the contractor's offer after the closing date of the solicitation (See FAR 15.208 for further information regarding late proposals). If discussions become necessary, page limitations may be placed on responses to Evaluation Notices (ENs). The specified page limits for EN responses will be identified in the letters forwarding the ENs to the offerors.

f. Minimum Offer Acceptance Period. The offer acceptance period is 90 days. The Offeror shall make a clear statement in its Offer Documentation that the offer is valid for a period of not less than 90 days from receipt of offers.

## 2. OFFER FILES

a. Format. The submission shall be clearly indexed and logically assembled. Each volume shall be clearly identified and shall begin at the top of a page. All pages of each volume shall be appropriately numbered and identified by the complete company name, date and solicitation number in the header and/or footer.

b. File Packaging. All offer files shall be submitted as separate files in their native/original format, i.e. doc, xls, pdf.

c. Content Requirements. All information shall be confined to the appropriate Volume. The offeror shall confine submissions to essential matters, sufficient to define the offer and provide adequate basis for evaluation. Offerors are responsible for including sufficient details in a concise manner, to permit a complete and accurate evaluation of the offer. Proprietary information shall be clearly marked. Offer shall include the following:

(1) Volume I - Technical. The technical offer shall contain one file which addresses the technical portion of the offer, specific and complete in every detail. The technical offer shall at a minimum address the required specifications for the specific Brand Name/Model ADAMS-RCID-OH (Over Head) 02-0706-0013-ASSY for the AN/TPS-70 Radar System. The technical offer shall clearly demonstrate that the offer is for the specific model required in the solicitation.

(2) Volume II – Price. Solicitation, Offer and Award Documents and Certifications/ Representations. Offeror's price offer shall contain the following:
