**PR4575306 FOR SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF LOCAL Newspapers  
Questions and Answers**

Q - What is the time that you want the newspapers to be delivered at the embassy?

A – On normal U.S. Embassy working days, papers/journals which have been printed by early morning should be delivered at 7:30am. Papers which are manufactured later should be delivered by 9:30am. On non-working days, items should be held by the agent and delivered on the next working day, except as specified below.

Delivery locations are

- The JAO Compound on 498 Avenue Col. Lukusa, Gombe
- The U.S. Embassy compound at 310 Avenue des Aviateurs, Gombe
- On Saturdays and U.S. holidays, a very small number of papers/journals will also be delivered to two residences in Gombe, the addresses of which will be specified upon award

Q - I would like to know how much you paid for the same service in the previous years.

A - The amount we contracted for during the last three month period was \$18,515.40. This reflects the order placed for papers/journals that were printed by companies in business during this period. Some of the publishers whose papers/journals we bought earlier than three months ago have gone out of business. The pricing charts in our solicitation reflect only companies which are still in business. Since companies in Kinshasa often go in or out of business, the pricing charts should be treated as estimates.
