Dear Consulate general representative,

There are many foreigners living in Curaçao and among them there are several small business owners who buy products in their countries or in other countries. They then bring these products into Curaçao in order to sell them here. Leisure travelers also shop abroad, obtain certain products and enter Curaçao with gifts or money.

By means of this letter, Customs Curaçao would like to request your Consulate general to provide the citizens of the country you represent with the following information and the information in the enclosed folder.

- Travelers can see upon entering Curaçao that they can choose between the Green Channel when they don't have anything to declare and the Red Channel if they have something to declare. It is important for travelers to choose the correct Channel to avoid any inconvenience.
- As from November 1 of this year, it shall not be possible to pay Import tax with cash or check anymore. However, there will be a transitional period until December 31, 2016.
- In the enclosed folder, Customs will also elaborate on important aspects prescribed by the law. The idea is to make this folder available to all travelers.
