U.S. FOL Organizes Community Relations Project at Orphanage

Staff from the U.S. Forward Operating Location (USFOL) on Curacao commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Mike Price are organizing a community relations project at the “Meant to Shine Foundation” orphanage in Barber. The service men and women will continue with a landscaping and clean-up project on Wednesday which started last month.

The U.S. FOL, 429th Expeditionary Operations Squadron, supports multinational aircraft operations that conduct detection, monitoring and tracking missions supporting counter-drug efforts in the region. FOL Curaçao was formed as a result of an agreement between the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the United States whereby aircraft and crews deploy to the FOL on a temporary basis to conduct mission operations. FOL military and civilian personnel often volunteer their services in support of community projects and are pleased to partner with local agencies in reaching out to the people of Curaçao.
