

The US Embassy in Nicosia, Cyprus is seeking to engage a general contractor to provide support services for a major project beginning in July 2011 on the US Embassy grounds. The general scope of work requires the removal of two existing exterior prefabricated access stairs that block clear access to the air intake shaft into the generator room; Removal of a cover canopy over the supply air shaft leading into the generator room; Removal of the security grates from the air shaft opening; Removal of the turning vanes from the base of the air shaft. It will be the successful contractor's responsibility to use necessary caution to maintain all items and material removed in the condition found upon his/her arrival onsite to begin the removal.

After the completion of the major project, which consists of the removal of three generators and replacement of three new generators. All directly associated generator project work will be performed by an American based company.

The successful contractor shall reinstall all items removed during the initial phase of his/her work. The sequencing of this requested work will require the successful contractor to perform the work as described for phase one and leave the job site and return for the final phase of work , reinstalling all items removed in phase one at a later date. The return date will be determined by the work progress of the generator project. Interested contractors will be invited to view the job site and to better understand all the solicitation requirements and formulate a firm fixed price for the work requested.
