## Scope of work

**LOCATION: U.S Embassy Dar Es Salaam; 686 Old Bagamoyo Road.**

**Construct a new concrete cement road for the support compound – 6meter width; 100 running meters – Project 1**

**From existing main tarmac road at the entrance to AERA Club building complete with covered drainage channel on the side.**

### SCOPE OF WORKS:

1. Take necessary levels and peg the entire road area to be concreted
2. Clearance and levelling of the existing dirt road by removing the top soil and replacing it with 150mm sub base. Compact the area with vibrating roller. Dispose the top soil removed.
3. Supply and lay 200mm hard core base and 50mm thick sand bed thoroughly compacted with vibrating roller ready to receive a reinforced concrete slab.
4. Pour in sections 180mm reinforced concrete slab – grade 25 with appropriate expansion joints. The reinforcement shall be 10mm high tensile at 150mm center to center both ways.
5. The completed concrete road shall have natural gradient for drainage – rain water shall naturally drain away to drainage channel.
6. All expansion joints shall be filled with appropriate expansion compound.
7. Provide a covered storm water drainage channel on one side of the road - tapered bottom 500mm; top 900mm; height 800mm covered with slotted concrete covers.
8. Hand over the completed works with appropriate completion hand over documents to the Embassy.
9. Demobilize and clear all the debris from site.

### NOTES:

1. The Contractor shall furnish and supply all materials required by this scope of work.
2. The contractor should survey the property and verify the work required against the scope of works to determine if any discrepancies exist. The contractor shall be responsible for any errors, which might have been avoided by such a survey/review.
3. The contract will be a firm fixed price contract payable entirely in the currency indicated in the bid. No additional sums will be payable on account of any escalation in the cost of materials, equipment or labor, or because of the contractor's failure to properly estimate or accurately predict the cost or difficulty of achieving the results required by this scope of works.
4. On award of the contract, the contractor shall furnish detailed working drawing / installation/ construction procedure for approval. No works shall be carried out without approval.
