The SolarDrive Container Power Unit by TecLeaf

Dear Madam Ambassador,

First of all we would like to thank you for your support in our SolarDrive Container Power Solution.

Since our meeting at Hydrema we have met with Foreign Comparative Testing (FCT) in Baltimore on board the Danish Frigate "Esbern Snare". FCT arranged a meeting with US Army base "Natick" in Boston. The meetings were successful and FCT has told us they will support some test versions to be tested by Natick.

The SolarDrive Container Power Unit will be manufactured and sold through TecLeaf which is a newly established Danish company where you met all the owners at Hydrema in Støvring (Former minister of Defense Mr. Søren Gade, Mr. Jan H. Christiansen, Mr. Bjarne Kolbo and Mr. Peter Randow). Jan and Peter are also co-owners of SolarDrive which makes this project a very nice Danish alliance. However, all the units to be sold in America will be manufactured in America incl. batteries, converter and inverter technology as well as the container frame. Hence, this project will not only create jobs in Denmark, but certainly also in America, assuming we get the orders from the US Military as we expect.

Any of this would not have been possible without your support and for that we are truly grateful.

As soon as Natick has approved the product we understand that DoD also will get involved to make the final approval. On this matter we are still not certain of the procedure, and we may contact your office for information if or when, we come that far.
